Skate Park

Many of our residents are suggesting that we need a skate park for our youth in Paengaroa. We have started a conversation with the Western Bay of Plenty District Council staff about progressing this and it would be great to have as many people attend the AGM 13 February 7pm at Paengaroa Hall to get this project started.

Katikati, Waihi, Omokoroa and Te Puke have all achieved variations on a skate park theme. It is critical that we hear where and how you would like to see this developed. The suggestions so far are Conway Road reserve, Paengaroa Domain ie ED and the area beside the Hall, where the old Playcentre was removed from.

There are lots of grants that we can apply for and the more support we have, the more credibility the applications will have.

Parks and Reserves

Plans for Old Coach Road - Pokopoko stream land have been progressing by the Paengaroa Community Association reserves sub-committee and we are having ongoing conversations with the Western Bay District Council to identify how this can be progressed.
