

Project Reports: (TAKEN FROM THE MINUTES OF MEETING 4TH August 2015)

- **Wagon Restoration** and plans for location and covering – Plaque? Need to Prioritise preferred sites and investigate placement ASAP. Four sites as options-Hall, Triangle, E.D., Notice board area opposite Trading Post Cafe. Committee to think on placement and to give consideration to how the wagon will be available to the public yet safe from vandalism. Bruce and Cindy to establish who owns which pieces of land and approach Council and Transit accordingly.
- **Permanent Art works** – Comvita wall and Ag contactors Wall. Glenn informed meeting of \$4076 funds remaining from Community Plan Implementation and immediately available for completion of an action from CP. Suggested Choose 1 or 2 items and target money for these. Art Works seen as one option, Surveillance system for Village Rubbish Bins, Cycle Way, Wagon and History Plaques?
- **Eastern Districts Access** and SH33 speed controls (See Chairpersons Report Attached.).
- Indoor Pool - Stage 2 What next? School waiting for a sustained roll of 250+
- **Cycle Way** – John F keeping the pressure on, especially with Eastern Arterial Route now open along with its Cycleway to Maketu.
- **Civil Defence** - Community Welfare Plan – Emergency Preparedness – Shake Up Day. Include Soup Night report back. Phil Richards has future planning process in hand.
- **Membership** Report 18 New Members -35 total at present. Cindy doing a wonderful job with this.
- **Community Gardens** – Chris at Comvita Caf

- **TEL a great road**. Kiwi 360 put on a great fan fare as the base for the Paengaroa end on the opening day festivities. Congratulations and thanks to the locals who participated.
- **Public Rubbish Bins**. (Chair persons Report.)
- **Constitution Update**. (Bruce to send to Cindy to Upload onto Website, along with recommended changes so that the community members can read and comment on changes. Then we will be ready for a special meeting on 3rd November at 7.00pm, Paengaroa Hall to approve constitution.

Other General Business:

- **Bus Services** – Cindy submitted to BOPRC plan. Rachael Clark (Maketu Community Board) reported. Aiming for a loop service to allow access to health services and workers getting to and from work. At this stage 5 days a week, suggested times 8.00am, 11.00am, 2.00pm and 5.00pm. Need to consult with community and all potential users of service to see what times they would prefer and where pick up would be. Aim for 3 to for loops per day.

Barry Reid will ensure current Rotorua Bus comes into village for pick up and drop off, instead of the current drop off on state highway 33 either side, adjacent to Gull / Bucktons.

Glenn suggested a meeting be arranged between Paengaroa Community Assn Rep , Te Puke Community Board (Peter Millar) and Maketu Community Board along with Barry Reid from Regional Council Transport manager to coordinate efforts to improve Bus Services , time tables and pick up points.

Use WBOPDC for some of the promotional advertising of services once worked through for trial of bus services. Cindy to follow up.

- **Tourism Bus**: Rachel shared her special project regarding a “Tourism Bus “ on Saturday(s) possibly a promotional service , once per month or periodic. Aiming to take passengers around all cafes / tourist businesses / sites. Between 10.00am and 4.00pm. Cost around \$1000 per day for 6 hr hire. Rachael is keen to hand this project over to another. **A volunteer in the business/tourism sector will be appreciated.**

• **Public Rubbish bins** around Paengaroa. Linda pushing this along to upgrade the current bins. WBOPDC looking into pricing. An upgrade would be complimented by a communication campaign and possible funding for video surveillance within the village.

• **Community Plan projects**: Linda working to explore funding options for a paid part-time Facilitator to keep Community Plan projects on track and to improve communications between volunteers and potential volunteers. Linda aiming to meet up with Francis Kraven – Maketu Hauora –Manager who hold the contract for funding Employment of Clester, Maketu’s paid facilitator.

• **Eastern Districts Sports Grounds** – Parks and Recreation Planning new development plan. Talk to Rory re this Plan and need to continue to press for upgrade of off road parking - front boundary fence moving back to accommodate parallel parking for events. Need to have an ED rep designated to PCA.

• **Art event** January 2016 – Arts Event at Paengaroa – Linda applying to Creative Communities for Funding of a paid part time event coordinator. Say 50 hours for the project. Currently in draft form. Cindy and Linda to complete.
