Paengaroa School Hall is currently being reclad with a new stage extension being built. The foundations are currently underway.

School is a little different in 2022 with the Ministry of Health and Ministry of Education providing guidance and new rules to try and protect the schools capacity to remain open in the Covid pandemic.

The traffic Light system - Covid Protection Framework is being refined as we live through the pandemic. So, it's masks, sanitizer, careful cleaning, social distancing, contact tracing scanning and signing into the school office.

All children, parents and staff are expected to stay home if sick, even slightly sick. If potentially exposed to Covid then staff, parents and pupils are expected to stay home until the facts show that they are well and free of Covid.

Top School for 2022 has been postponed until 25th September 2022, this decision is to try and ensure we keep our community safe and that we do not host a "Super spreader " event.

The pupils will be attending special Swimming lessons from Baywave staff during the next week or two. Baywave swimming instructors use our school pools. This is a wonderful initiative subsidised by our Top School Raffle which is currently on sale and closes on the 13th March 2022. The Top School Raffle will be drawn on the 13th March 2022.

The school is slowly growing at present which is quite exciting. We have employed two young teachers - one for the senior school and one for the junior school.

The school continues to be a central hub for our community working with our Board of Trustees and PTA to make Paengaroa School a school where learning has no boundaries and "success breeds success" like nothing else for our learners.
