Many really good ideas for fundraising and for continuing to refresh the schools playgrounds and facilities.

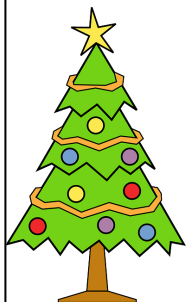
The current project is to outdoor carpet the Junior Sunshade area, but we need to paint and freshen up the structure first.
